District Rural Development Cell (DRD Cell)

The District Rural Development Cell, G.T.A. was from 2003 until March 2013 entrusted with implementing the Swarnajayanti Gram Swarojgar Yojana (SGSY), which has transitioned into National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) from April 2013.

Objective:

SGSY/NRLM is the largest self employment scheme for the rural poor whose objective is to bring the poor families above the poverty line by forming them into Self Help Groups (SHGs), enhancing their capacities with trainings and by providing them with income generating assets, through bank credit and Government subsidy.

Target:

Families living below the poverty line (BPL), in rural areas.

Self Help Group:

A group of 10 to 20 BPL persons preferably women from the same socio-economic background coming together voluntarily with the aim of generating income to rise above the poverty level and with group savings as their binding factor constitute a Self Help Group.

Funding Pattern:

The SGSY/NRLM is a centrally sponsored scheme. The financing of the programme is shared between the Centre and the States in the ratio of 75:25. The Central allocation earmarked for the States is distributed in relation to the incidence of poverty in the States.

Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan formally known as Total Sanitation Campaign started from 2006, and is being executed by the District Rural Development Cell, G.T.A. The objective is to accelerate the sanitation coverage in the rural areas so as to comprehensively cover the rural community through renewed strategies and saturation approach.

Objectives

The main objectives of the NBA are as follows:

- a) Bring about an improvement in the general quality of life in the rural areas.
- b) Accelerate sanitation coverage in rural areas to achieve the vision of Nirmal Bharat by 2022 with all gram panchayats in the country attaining Nirmal status.
- c) Motivate communities promoting sustainable sanitation facilities through awareness creation and health education.
- d) To cover remaining schools not covered under “Sarva Siksha Abhiyan” and Anganwadi Centers in rural areas with proper sanitation facilities and undertake proactive promotion of hygiene education and sanitary habits among students.
- e) Develop community managed environmental sanitation systems focusing on solid & liquid waste management for overall cleanliness in the rural areas.

Components

The major components of the NBA are as follows:

- a) Information, Education & Communication (IEC)
- b) Individual Household Latrines (IHHL)
- c) Community Sanitary Complex
- d) School Toilet Blocks
- e) Anganwadi Toilets
- f) Solid & Liquid Waste Management
