- 1. Block Level Training Programme:** Block level training to the Fish farmers to be conducted in all the eight hill blocks of Darjeeling district . In this training the farmers will be given training on the culture of fishes in a scientific way which will help in increasing the productivity thus uplifting the social status of the fish farmers. Stipend will be given to all the beneficiaries.
- 2. District Level Training:** The progressive fish farmers who had earlier been trained in the block level training will be again given training in the district level.
- 3. Distribution of fish seed:** Free distribution of fish seed to the fish farmers in all the eight hill blocks of Darjeeling district. This will encourage the people to grow more fish in the hill areas.
- 4. Fishery Requisites:** Free distribution of net and hundies to the fish farmers in all the eight hill blocks of Darjeeling district which is a much needed requisite in pisciculture. Netting should be done on a regular basis on the ponds for proper growth of the fishes and hundies is needed for keeping the fishes while netting and also during harvesting.
- 5. Reyang Fish Farm:** Conversion of Reyang Fish Farm to an operational fish farm for producing fish seeds of Exotic Carps. The fish seeds can later be distributed to the fish farmers.
- 6. Construction of new community ponds:** New community ponds to be constructed in all the blocks of the hills. This community ponds may be handed over to the Self Help groups for fish production. This will in turn help in employment generation in the area and also increase the fish production of the area.
- 7. Mirik Aquarium:** Completion of Mirik Aquarium and inclusion of the Office of The Fishery Extension Officer in the same building as at present there is no structure for the Office of the FEO in Mirik.
